Notes for Dual-Degree Biology/Biology Education Students:

Students adding a Biology Degree need 27 credit hours of General Education Courses—9 of these hours need to be at the 2000+ level.

Breakdown of General Education Requirements:

- 1. 6 total hours of Behavioral Sciences
 - A. Psychology 1000 (required)
 - B. Student choice of a 2000-level Behavioral course
- 2. 9 total hours of Social Sciences
 - A. History (required)
 - B. Political Science (required)
 - C. One of the required teacher development courses will finish this requirement.
- 3. 12 total hours of Humanities
 - A. Communication 1200 (required)
 - B. Student choice of a World International 2000-level course
 - C. Student choice of a 2000-level Humanities course
 - D. One of the required teacher development courses will finish this requirement.

Variations and hints:

- 1. History 2210, if chosen to meet the history requirement, will count towards the 9-credit-hour requirement for 2000-level General Education classes.
- 2. Language minors in Spanish and French will take two literature classes (3420 and 3430) that count as Humanities.
- 3. Biology 3650 (Ecology) is offered fall semester only and is Writing Intensive (WI).
- 4. Biology 3210 (Plant Systematic) is offered spring semester only.
- 5. Students will choose their Biology Capstone course. Selections vary by semester.
- 6. Any student might have unique exceptions that could change the Plan of Study (for example, the addition of a minor, Unified Science, or Middle-School certification).
